<p style="text-align: center;">Myself</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You could discuss with your child about what they look like, what colour hair and eyes they have • You could also look at their name and the importance of their name and that they are special and have a special name. You could also talk about the things that they like to do and toys that they like to play with. • You could look at photographs of when they were born and talk about if they still look the same or if they have changed. • The children could bring in photographs of 	<p style="text-align: center;">Friends and Family</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You could talk to your child about their friends, both at home and in Nursery. What do they like doing with their friends. • Talk about who is in their family, the children could look at • photographs of their family and maybe even bring them in to nursery to show their friends 	<p style="text-align: center;">My Environment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a look around your home and talk to your child about it, how many rooms has it got. What number is on your front door? Perhaps you could take photos of it or make maps of your garden together. • You could have a look at your local shops and talk to the children about the things that you see on your way there, both the things that you like and also the things that you don't e.g. litter, graffiti etc
